These prices are effective as of March 1, 2015, but are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected; we do not place additional charges on these items. This list does not include all the costs for final disposition that you may be required to pay.

### **Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff, and Overhead..... \$2,095.00**

Our professional services include but are not limited to: counseling, availability on a 24-hour basis; assistance of staff in all necessary phases of arrangements; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; obtaining, preparing and filing of necessary notices, authorizations and consents, certificates and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties; assistance to family following funeral and final disposition. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving of remains.)

### **Transfer of Remains to the Funeral Home (within 25 mile radius) ..... \$425.00 (if additional man power is needed after 2 men, each additional person is \$125.00)**

### **Embalming\*..... \$750.00**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial. **(Tissue and long bone donation "Organ Donation" add \$425.00)**

### **Other Preparation of the Body ..... \$325.00**

Includes dressing, casketing, cosmetology, positioning, etc.

Postmortem examination ..... **\$300.00**

Sanitization (washing and setting features prior to cremation)..... **\$150.00**

Refrigeration..... **\$125.00/24-Hours**

### **Weekend Funeral Fee ..... \$350.00**

The Weekend fee was implemented to meet the demand for each and every family who now wishes for a weekend funeral. This fee covers all the additional overhead as well as overtime to pay our staff. We have done this so that every funeral can be handled with adequate staff as well as the additional preparation needed to properly maintain the deceased. Refrigeration charges may also be incurred depending on the time lines involved and the care of the deceased.

### **Use of Facilities and Staff for Evening OR Morning Viewing with Funeral Service at the Funeral Home ..... \$945.00**

Use of visitation or viewing rooms including but not limited to family rooms and reception area. Our services include set-up of visitation area, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, supervision and attendance during the visitation. This is for 3 hours, **each additional hour is \$225.00. This applies to all below.**

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, care of remains, local transportation of remains to funeral home, and to cemetery or crematory. No attending rights or services.

Pennsylvania Rules and Regulations number 13.201 6(i) require that any human remains be held 24 hours beyond death shall be embalmed or sealed in a container that will not allow fumes or odors to escape or kept under refrigeration, if this does not conflict with a religious belief or medical examination.

**Direct Cremation\*..... Various packages starting at \$1795.00**

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs, removal of remains, transportation to local crematory, necessary authorizations, container, and cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard and composition materials.

**Immediate Burial with Minimum Casket\* ..... \$5,640.00**

Our charge for an immediate burial (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains, and local transportation to cemetery. This includes embalming fee and a non-protective casket.

**Immediate Burial with Casket Provided by Purchaser\* ..... \$4545.00**

Our charge for an immediate burial (without ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff, a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains, and local transportation to cemetery. This includes embalming fee.

**CREMATORY FEE'S- THE CREMATORY IS OWNED  
AND OPERATED BY THE DONOHUE FAMILY-**

The Crematory is located off site at our Upper Darby Facility, the crematory is owned by an affiliate company that we own, therefore it is considered a cash advance item. The charges for our crematory facility are as follows:

Basic Charge for Crematory: .....	... <b>\$495.00</b>

Basic Charge includes a temporary cardboard box, if separate portions are required an additional charge of \$15.00 will be incurred.

If an urn or receptacle is provided by the family an inurnment fee will be applied: ..... **\$ 50.00**

Refrigeration Charges are on a 24 hour time period, charges are as follows ..... **\$125.00**

Per day until authorization is given and all forms are signed by the legal next of kin.
